Daler-Rowney System3 Screen Printing Medium for paper .I have also used wallpaper paste as a printmaking medium.

System3 Acrylic Paint. You can get a System 3 Acrylic Starter set from Daler Rowney is a set of 6 x 22ml basic acrylic colours from the System 3 range.The acrylic colours included are:-Cadmium Yellow Hue,Cadmium Red Hue,Ultramarine,Emerald, Burnt Umber, Titanium White. Or you can buy the colours individually.
