Monotype first print - systems 3 acrylic and systems 3 print medium

Monotype Prints

First Image

Monotype prints offer ways to achieve painterly prints .

My screen is 90T

I've masked off my screen to the size of my squeegee

The system 3 acrylic paint can be mixed with system 3 acrylic medium to a 50/50 ratio .

Select a range of brushes a range of different sizes .

Put paper under the screen

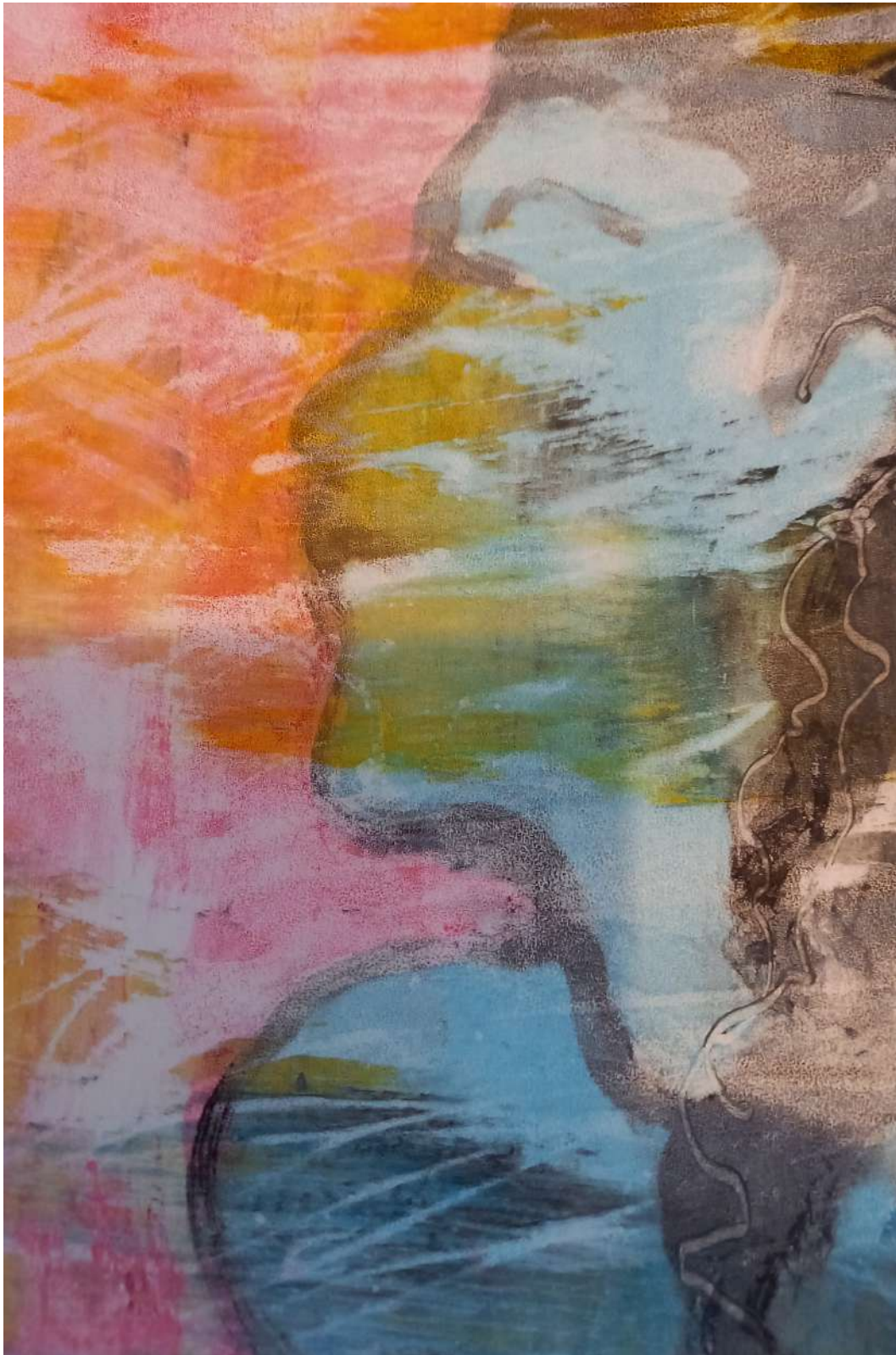
To keep the screen from touching the paper, put a pencil or pot under the screen.

Paint your image by filling in the whole area of the screen mesh - leave no gaps !

You'll need to paint blocks of colour - no shading at this point.

Take away the pencil or pot and print with your squeegee at 40 degree angle.

Reveal the print . This can be over printed with a line drawing.



Systems 3 colour and print medium , layering colour . 2nd print

Next

2nd Image - ghost

Hold your screen up and you will see a ghost image

Next put more paper down.

Place a pot under the screen.

Dribble colourless medium over the top and print - we'll be experimenting with layering images

Paint more ink with a brush and print over the top .

This time don't add any more acrylic medium

Take the pot away and print.
